SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The Examination will be held in three stages namely:

Preliminary Examination (Objective)
Main Written Examination
Viva-Voce. (Interview)

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

Preliminary Examination shall be of objective type multiple choice. The question paper for Preliminary Examination shall be of two hours duration. It shall consist of 125 questions and each question shall carry 04 marks. The objective type multiplechoice question for the Preliminary Examination shall be from the syllabus for the Main Examination.

Note: 1/5 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer.
