- Eligibility criteria LL.B.
- ➤ Age Limit Not more than 40 years
- ➤ (For SC/ST/BC/EWS 5 years relaxation)
- 1. The Competitive Examination for the recruitment to the post of Civil Judge shall be conducted by Recruiting Authority in two stages i.e. Preliminary Examination and Main Examination as per the scheme specified in ScheduleIV. The marks obtained in the preliminary examination by the candidate who are declared qualified for admission to the main examination will not be counted for determining their final merit.
- 2. The number of candidate to be admitted to the main examination will be fifteen times the total number of vacancies (category wise) to be filled in the year but in the said range all those candidates who secure the same percentage of marks as may be fixed by the Recruiting Authority.
- 3. On the basis of marks secured in the main examination, candidates to the extent of three times of total number of vacancies (category wise) shall be declared qualified to be called for interview. The competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Civil Judge shall consist of:

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The Examination will be held in three stages namely:

1. Preliminary Examination (Objective)

(100 Marks)

2. Main Written Examination

(300 Marks)

3. Viva-Voce. (Interview)

(35 Marks)

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

The Preliminary Examination shall be an objective type examination in which 70% weightage will be given to the subjects prescribed in syllabus for Law PaperI and Law Paper-II and 30% weightage shall be given to test proficiency in Hindi and English language. There shall be no negative marking. The marks obtained in the preliminary examination shall not be Counted towards the final selection.

INTERVIEW

Interviewing a candidate, the suitability for employment to the service shall be tested with reference to his record at the School, College and University, and his character, personality, address and physique. The questions, which may be put to him, may be of a general nature and will not necessarily be academic or legal. The candidate will also be put questions to test his general knowledge including knowledge of current affairs and present-day problems. Marks shall also be awarded for the candidate's proficiency in the Rajasthani dialects and his knowledge of social customs of Rajasthan. The marks so awarded shall be added to the marks obtained in the written test by each candidate.
