SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The Examination will be held in three stages namely:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

The Preliminiary Examination will consist of one paper contraining Multiple Choice Type Questions on General Ability Test with two hour duration. The Preliminary Examination will be a Screening Test for selection of candidates for admission to the Main Examination. A limited no. of candidates, Maximum 10(ten) times of total posts (in category wise) will be selected merit wise on the basis of the result of the Preliminary Examination, subject to securing minimum qualifying marks (60% for UR candidates and 50% for reserved category candidates). The marks obtained by the candidates in the preliminary Examination will not be taken into account for the purpose of determining the final merit list.
